Chronology

1998: The necessity for a European Engineers Chamber was presented in Dresden at the 1st European Engineering Forum.

2004: At the 4th European Engineering Forum in Vienna the European Council of Engineers Chambers was founded and the Presidents of the Engineering Chambers of Austria, Croatia, Czech Republic, Germany, Italy, Hungary, Montenegro, Poland, Slovakia and Slovenia signed the founding-documents.

Further enlargement of the ECEC: Accession of Serbia (2006), Bulgaria (2007), Greece (2008), Spain (2009), Cyprus and The Former Yugoslav Republic of Macedonia (2010).

Membership

Members of the ECEC are the Chambers of Engineers or representative public bodies of the profession of Engineers, who are professionally recognised according to national law in their country or national liaison associations of these. They must be established in the EU or in states applying for membership in the EU or in potential candidate countries for the EU accession.
