### **New European Bauhaus: Awards for outstanding projects and solutions**

The New European Bauhaus (NEB) initiative calls on all Europeans to imagine and build together a sustainable and inclusive future that is beautiful for our eyes, minds, and souls.

The Prizes recognise and reward existing projects and young people's concepts, which demonstrate that the sustainable solutions promoted by the European Green Deal can also be inclusive and beautiful, bringing high-quality experiences to people's everyday lives. The New European Bauhaus Prizes 2023 are open to applications from the EU Members States. For the first time, they are also open to the Western Balkans. Applicants can be EU or non-EU residents, as long as their projects are implemented in the EU or in the Western Balkans.

**The Prizes will be awarded in four thematic categories (for detailed descriptions, see the Guide to Applicants):**

-  **1 Reconnecting with nature**
-  **2 Regaining a sense of belonging**
-  **3 Prioritising the places and people that need it the most**
-  **4 The need for long-term, life-cycle thinking in the industrial ecosystem.**

In each of the four categories, there are three parallel competition strands:

- **Strand A:** “New European Bauhaus Champions”, devoted to existing and completed projects with clear and positive results.

*Application in Strand A must be submitted by the individual(s) or the organisation(s) (city or region, funder, organiser) who is/are entitled to represent the project.*

- **Strand B:** “New European Bauhaus Rising Stars”, dedicated to concepts submitted by young talents aged 30 or less. The concepts can be at different stages of development, from ideas with a clear plan to the prototype level.

*Application must be submitted by the individual or group of individuals who would be the author of the concept. All applicants in this strand must be aged 30 or less on the final day of call for applications. The application can also be submitted by an organisation, as long as all representatives of this organisation involved in the creation of the given concept are under 30 years old.*

- **Strand C:** “New European Bauhaus Education Champions”, devoted to initiatives focusing on education and learning. Both completed projects, as well as initiatives with a minimum level of maturity are eligible (see the Guide to Applicants for details).

*Application must be submitted by the individual(s) or organisation(s) who would be the author or a representative of the initiative.*

**There will be 15 prizes in total. The jury will select 12 winners (one winner for each category in each strand). Three winners will be selected through an open public voting (one winner per strand).**

All winners will receive a monetary prize:

- EUR 30,000 for winners of the New European Bauhaus Champions (Strand A) and New European Bauhaus Education Champions (Strand C),
- EUR 15,000 for winners of the New European Bauhaus Rising Stars (Strand B).

as well as a communication package provided by the Commission (e.g. promotion in the Commission’s social media and websites, production of a short video and support in promoting the projects).
